4:30-5:00 Coach Mitch Henderson

Assistant Coach for the Northwestern University Men's Basketball

Topic: "A Simple Press Attack Offense"

Mitch Henderson enters his seventh year on Bill Carmody's staff at Northwestern University (IL). Before joining the Northwestern staff, Mitch was a four-year starter at Princeton from 1994-98. Mitch helped the Tigers win three straight Ivy League titles, including two 14-0 records. Three of Mitch's teams made NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 1996 team that pulled off one of the tournament's most famous first round upsets over defending champion UCLA. Following his collegiate career, Mitch played professional basketball in the NBA and Europe.

Assistant Coach for the Chicago Bulls

Topic: "Adapting NBA Plays to the Junior High Level"

Bob Ociepka enters his first year with the Chicago Bulls. After playing collegiately at Quincy College (IL), Bob made a name for himself on the Chicago prep scene as Head Coach at Gordon Tech and York High Schools. In May of 2000, he was introduced into the Chicago Catholic League Hall of Fame. Bob brings more than 30 years of coaching experience to the Bulls, including 19 years in the NBA.

Head Basketball Coach at Northridge Prep School

Topic: "Teaching Young Players the Lost Art of Shooting"

Will Rey begins his 5th season at Northridge Prep and his 33rd season overall. His Northridge teams have a 69-44 record with one IHSA Regional Championship and three conference 2nd place finishes. In addition, Coach Rey was voted Conference Coach-of-the-Year in 2006-07 and 2007-08. Prior to arriving at Northridge in 2004, Will coached college basketball for 19 years at the University of Evansville (IN), Loyola University (IL), and Wright State University (OH); he also coached at Gordon Tech and Fenwick High Schools.

Head Men's Basketball Coach at DePaul University

Topic: "Passing & Catching: The Keys to Individual Player Development"

Jerry Wainwright enters his fourth year as Head Men's Basketball Coach at DePaul University, and 15th season as a NCAA Division I head coach. Jerry has taken his teams to seven post season tournaments including three NCAA berths and four NIT berths. Wainwright began his coaching career at Montrose High School in Denver, then as an assistant at East Leyden High School (IL), Head Coach at Highland Park High School (IL), Assistant Coach at Xavier University and Wake Forest., and then Head Coach at UNC-Wilmington, Richmond and DePaul University.
