General Information:

- League Fees: Grades 4th & 5th = \$75.00 per team, Grades 6th, 7th & 8th = \$125 per team (Please make checks payable to City Suburban Catholic Conference.)
- The official's fee will be **\$16.00** per match per team during the regular season and \$32.00 per team in the Quarter-Finals. If you are scheduling a single match, the referee will be paid \$37.00. The home team will pay the extra \$5.00 for the single match. The School Teams will pay for the Quarter-Final play-off games and the conference will pay for the Semi-Finals and Championship games.
- The host school must provide a scorekeeper and a timer, with one adult at the table.
- Every school **must** submit a roster of all team members, numbers and date of birth, signed by the school principal. Rosters must be turned in by your first game. Teams that have not submitted rosters prior to their first game will forfeit all games until the rosters are received. Any athlete may **ONLY** be rostered on one team, unless double rostered a grade up. All rosters are frozen 30 days after the season start date.
- **THE WINNING TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CALLING THE SCORE INTO THE CSCC VOICE MAIL WITHIN 72 HOURS OF THE GAME – PHONE NUMBER ABOVE.**
- Kneepads are recommended for all players and uniforms **must** have a 4" number on the front of the shirts and a 6" number on the back. **ALL PLAYERS SHOULD WEAR MATCHING AND LIKE COLOR SHIRTS AND SHORTS OR THEY MAY NOT PLAY.**

Play-off Information:

Play-offs are single elimination format.

- Trophies will be awarded to the first place team in both divisions – 12 individual trophies and a team trophy will be awarded.
- Play-off Trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place finishers at each grade level. **THE 4TH & 5TH GRADE DIVISIONS WILL BE INSTRUCTIONAL. NO STANDINGS, NO RECORDS AND NO PLAY-OFFS.**
- Playoff information is now incorporated in the volleyball rules. Please see the rules to learn about playoff eligibility, tie-breakers and seeding procedures.
